Pirie Memorial Trophy

This trophy was donated by Miss Janette Pirie in memory of her parents, Mr. And Mrs. James Trail Pirie. Mr. Pirie was one of the first presidents of the club when it met in the United Church, then existing on Columbia Street in White rock. He died in 1959 at the age of 79. Mrs Pirie passed away six years later. Longtime resident Miss Elizabeth Keeling (found of the Elizabeth Society) remembers next door neighbour Mr. Pirie and his wonderful garden on Columbia St. In 2001, Miss Pirie was 86 and still taking an interest in gardening in her little garden plot on the grounds of the condominium where she lived at that time.

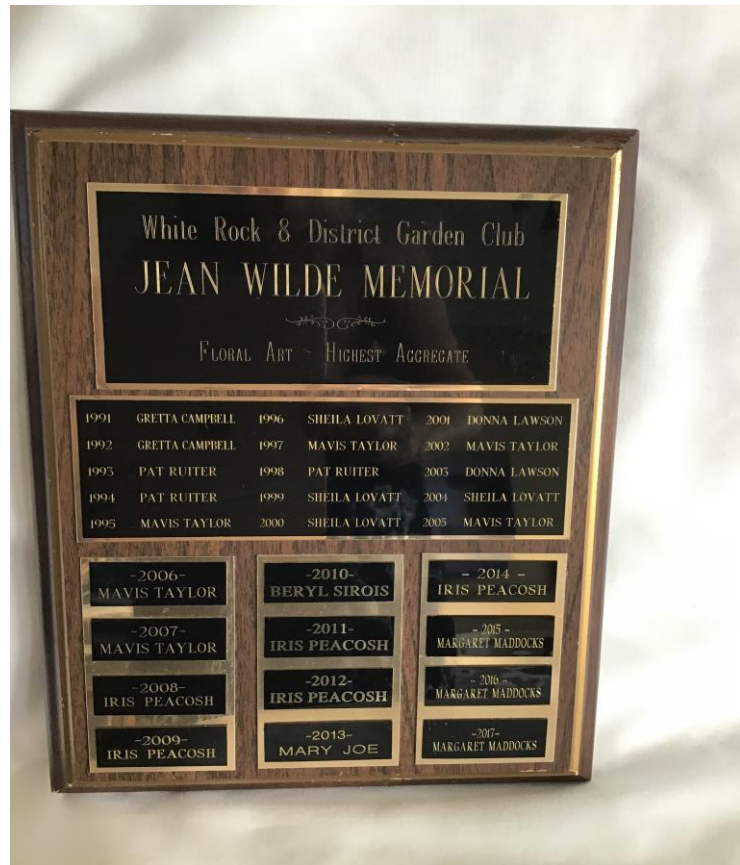
